EcoVadis rated Birla Carbon with an overall performance score of 71%, a significant improvement from last year's 65%, acknowledging Birla Carbon's continuous progress. This score places Birla Carbon in the **Top 1%** of suppliers in all categories from a database of over 30,000 registered participants.

The methodology covers 150 purchasing categories, 110 countries, and 21 CSR indicators.
